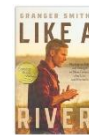

Please join us for Coffee Hour in the basement immediately following first service.



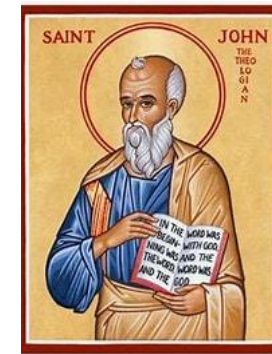
